1 Blessed are those whose transgression is fórgíven,  
whose sín is cóvered.

2 Blessed are those whom the LORD does nó t hól d gúilty,  
and in whose spirit there is nó déccéit. R

3 While I kept silence, my body wasted away  
through my groaning áll dáy lóng.

4 For day and night your hand was héavy úpón me;  
my strength was dried up as by the héat óf súmmer.

5 Then I acknowledged my sin to you,  
and I did not hide mý íniquity;

I said, "I will confess my transgressions tó thé LÓRD,"  
and you forgave the guilt óf mý sín. R

6 Therefore let all who are faithful  
offer práyer tó yóu;
